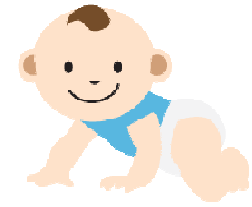

Developing Fine Motor Skills

Babies use their hands to touch, grasp, and hold onto things. They also use them to explore and learn about the world around them.

Here are some ways you can encourage fine motor skills:

-  Introduce new and interesting textures to touch: variety of fabrics, touch and feel books
-  Provide safe and easy objects to grasp and hold onto: rattles, keys on a ring, stuffed animals, squeeze toys
-  When they are ready to eat allow them to hold the spoon or grasp at small objects: Cheerios, small pieces of soft fruit, puff cereal
