Feeling and splashing water usually delights young infants. Once they can sit on their own, a small basin with about an inch of water and a few very simple props, like plastic cups and rubber toys, will keep them engaged. For older infants, their water play is likely to involve filling and dumping cups. They start to learn and understand quantity and size. When toys are added for water play, children discover what floats and what sinks. Water play is the beginning of learning about science. Each discovery is a wonderful surprise!
